STORY AND PRESENT SITUATION OF THE CHILD AND THE FAMILY

Cinderella lives with her parents, two brothers and her aunt. They live in a small rented house made out of bricks. The house has no tap water so there is an external pit latrine, which is shared. Her mother Irene sells fruits like mangoes, bananas, oranges and sometimes groundnuts on the streets of Kampala. Her father Dennis, on the other hand, is a contract painter, however his job is not so regular, since he only works on call. Therefore, Irene is the breadwinner of the family but her income is not enough to cater for all the family needs and sometimes they go without food. Cinderella is still in primary four as she started school late. She performs fairly in class. She loves to play volleyball.

THE INTERVENTION PLAN OF DISTANCE SUPPORT PROJECT

Your support will help Cinderella to go to school until the end of secondary or professional school so that she can acquire the skills which will allow her to face her life path. We will follow her through home and school visits, we will provide health care support and will involve her in recreational activities. We will help Irene and Dennis to find more ways of generating income through involving them in Financial training, and engaging them in Village Savings and Loan's association. Cinderella and her family will be followed by the Meeting Point International, founded by Rose Busingye, an Ugandan nurse who, together with the social workers, is offering psycho-social support to families affected by HIV/AIDS, with special attention to orphans and women. The women who met Rose leave an extraordinary experience of belonging and friendship which gives meaning to their lives. Together with you, there will be another donor that will help Cinderella just like other donors for other children, to make sure the organisation will remain a reference point for this community's rebirth.
